Background

The Sports Excellence Scholarship Fund (SESF) is a national registered charity. It supports primary and secondary school students aged 10 to 18 years old, who's financial circumstances would preclude them from otherwise participating at representative level for their state / territory or Australia. The charity started in 2012 and has Deductible Gift Recipient (DGR) status.

The SESF provides scholarships valued at \$1,000 each, as well as supports athletes with mentoring guidance and alumni education.

With 1 in 10 athletes selected to represent their state or territory facing financial constraints, there is an urgent need to support students to continue their sporting journey.

Committee Remit

- advise on activities within schools that will help promote the fund and increase our student application levels
- advise on the SESF "National Schools Week"
- Advise on our quarterly online "Sporting Masterclass" content
- advise on changes in policy and opportunities that may be available. This could include grants, conference speaking opportunities and other initiatives
- advise on activities for the fund within the school environment, including fundraising

Committee Composition

- Two principal class members per state / territory (16 in total)
- A mix of sport friendly male / female / primary and secondary principal class members from government, independent and catholic schools

Time Commitment

- One 45-minute online meeting per term
