THE ROLES

The SESF is seeking to appoint three independent Board Members to help guide our organisation through an exciting period of expansion and diversification. We are looking for Board members whose values align with the SESF's purpose, and with skills & networks in three key areas:

1. Philanthropic / Grants Expertise

This board member has a deep understanding of the philanthropic and grants space.

They are well connected in this area, through family offices, private ancillary funds and foundations.

They have a firm understanding of the grants landscape, where to apply and when.

They may have worked in this space for a larger charity.

They may be recently retired and keen to share their wisdom in the sector.

2. Corporately well-connected at Executive level

This board members remit is to help us identify and connect with potential corporate partners. Ideally this person is a CEO of a medium to large company who can connect us with other CEO's. Sponsorship is the key goal, however there are additional opportunities to support in helping generate income at SESF events hosted in the corporate sector.

3. Marketing and communications Expertise.

This board member may be a CMO of a large company, work in or run an advertising agency or similar or work in the media and be well versed in the power of social media.

Their key remits would be to raise awareness of the work SESF does to:

- a) Raise our profile amongst communities across Australia so we continue to reach all the rights families and emerging athletes
- b) Raise our profile across corporate and philanthropic networks to help obtain greater financial support

WHO WE'RE LOOKING FOR

The SESF strongly encourages applications for this board positions from Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander people and from female applicants as we strive for board diversity. Appointment would be on an initial term of 2 years. With our base and meetings held in Melbourne, we encourage Melbourne-based applicants; however we will consider applications from across Australia.

Board Directors will be required to prepare for and attend eight meetings annually, and may attend remotely or face-to-face if and where possible. In addition, members are expected to represent SESF occasionally at events.
